Sealed Bids for the construction of the <u>Keokuk, Iowa, Hot Mix Asphalt "Mill & Fill"</u>, PSBA Project No. RK-17-507B will be received, by the <u>City of Keokuk, Iowa</u>, at the office of the <u>City Clerk, 415 Blondeau Street, Keokuk, IA</u>, until <u>4:00 pm</u> local time on <u>January 29, 2019</u>, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. Proposals shall be acted upon by the City Council within 60 days following the Bid Opening. The Project consists of:

Mill & Fill on 13<sup>th</sup> Street from Palean Street to Johnson Street, in the City of Keokuk, Iowa

Mill approximately 6,970 square yards of bituminous pavement to a depth of four inches and install four inches of hot mix asphalt pavement to bring the street back to original grade. The project also includes reconstructing sidewalks at the intersections to meet ADA Accessibility Standards. Major items of work include 1,650 tons of Hot Mix Asphalt, remove and replace 310 square yards of sidewalk and remove and replace 430 feet of concrete curb and gutter.

Each bid shall be prepared on forms furnished with the bid documents. The proposal shall be submitted in a sealed envelope separate from the required bid security.

Each bidder shall accompany the bid with a bid security, as defined in Section 26.8 of the Iowa Code and as specified by the governmental entity, in the amount of not less than 5% of the total amount of the bid and as specified by the governmental entity.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis as indicated in the Bid Form. The work shall be done under contract and in accordance with the provisions of the project contract documents, specifications and plans. By virtue of statutory authority, a preference will be given to products and provisions grown and coal produced within the State of Iowa, and to the Iowa domestic labor. The work under the proposed contract shall commence on or after the date specified in the written Notice to Proceed. The project shall be substantially completed by <u>August 9, 2019</u>, and completed and ready for final payment by <u>September 13, 2019</u>.

Upon request and receipt of the document deposit indicated above plus a non-refundable shipping charge, if any, the Issuing Office will transmit the Bidding Documents via delivery service. The shipping charge amount will depend on the shipping method selected by the prospective Bidder.
